Key Passage

Joshua 24:14-16

"Now fear the Lord and serve Him with faithfulness. Throw away the gods your ancestors worshipped beyond the Euphrates River and in Egypt, and serve the Lord. But if serving the Lord seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord."

Discussion Questions

2. What efforts do you take to serve others? What opportunities have you had to serve others that you might've missed?
3. Read Genesis 2:18-22. Eve was created to serve as a suitable helper to Adam; service is literally intertwined with our DNA. How does that impact how you feel about the importance of service?
4. How did Jesus model service in His life? What stands out to you about the way He served?
5. Pastor Greg said on Sunday that when we serve, it connects us to each other and to God. How have you seen this in your life?
6. Sometimes you need to not only served, but to be served. Is that truth difficult for you to accept? Why or why not?
7. What's difficult about service for you? What can you do to overcome this obstacle?
8. What are some examples of great acts of service in the Bible?
