### **Key Passage**

Exodus 3:7-10

"The Lord said, 'I have indeed seen the misery of my people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned for their suffering. So I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey—the home of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites, and Jebusites. And now the cry of the Israelites has reach me, and I have seen the way the Egyptians are oppressing them. So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people the Israelites out of Egypt."

### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Have you ever had someone fight for you? Help you conquer something that you couldn't take on on your own?
- **2.** Read Exodus 3:8 again. What does it mean to you that God "came down"? What do you think that looked like? Does God still come down today?
- **3.** In Exodus 3:9, God says "now the cry of the Israelites has reached me." The Israelites had been under Egyptian rule for hundreds of years at that point. Do you believe God didn't hear them previously? What did He mean by this statement, and how does it apply to your life?
- **4.** Read Proverbs 15:3. Do you believe that God sees you at all times? Do you believe He's constantly monitoring your well-being?
- 5. Why do you think God chose 12 plagues as the manner to get Pharaoh to relent and let the Israelites go?
- 6. Read Exodus 9:6-7 and Exodus 9:25-26. What do these verses make you think about your life?
- 7. Despite the plagues wrecking havoc on his people and land, Pharaoh still wouldn't let the Israelites go. Do you ever feel like, despite your hard work, you just can't make progress on something really important?
- 8. Do you believe that God has a good future for you? Why or why not?
- **9.** Read Exodus 12:35-36. Not only did the Israelites go free, but they took the Egyptians wealth, too! Have you seen this idea play out in your life?
