## **Key Passage**

Romans 8:17

Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in His sufferings in order that we may also share in His glory.

## **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Read 1 John 3:1. What does it mean to you to be a "child of God"?
- **2.** When is a time that you felt totally unworthy of an honor, recognition, or compliment someone gave you? How did you respond?
- 3. Do you consider yourself worthy of God's love?
- 4. Christ's sacrifice means we are co-heirs with Christ. How do you respond to that invitation?
- **5.** In Luke 15:11-32, Jesus tells the Parable of the Prodigal Son. But there are two sons in this story: the younger who spurned the love of his father for the spoils of the world, and the older who thought his good works earned him honor from his father (Luke 11:28-30). Which son do you identify with more? Do you think your status as one of the sons affects how God feels about you?
- **6.** The father came after both sons, running out to meet the young (Luke 15:20) and leaving his party for the older (Luke 15:28). How does this parable display God's relentless love?
- **7.** Do you determine your merit based on your works, wealth, and standing in the community? Why or why not?
- **8.** Pastor Greg said that your worth in God's eyes has nothing to do with what you've done, good or bad. Do you agree? Why or why not?
- **9.** When is a time you've shown unconditional love to someone who didn't deserve it? How did they respond?
