Icebreaker

Key Passage

Luke 11:41-42

"Martha, Martha," the Lord answered, "you are worried and upset about many things, but few things are needed—or indeed, only one. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken from her."

Discussion Questions

1. Read Luke 11:38-42. Why do you think Jesus reprimanded Martha?
2. Mary and Martha had different ways of serving Jesus. Martha's method was doting over the Lord and serving others, while Mary was devoted to the Lord's teaching. Do you ever feel like Martha when others serve God in a different way than you do?
3. God gives us each different gifts and abilities, thus we contribute in varied ways in His ministry. What are your spiritual gifts? Have you taken the opportunity to think about how God has gifted you?
4. When you think of who you are and how God created you completely uniquely, does it give you satisfaction? Why or why not?
5. Do you ever feel jealous of others' giftings? What can you do in those times to remind you of the gifts God has given you?
6. Read Luke 10:27. How did Mary and Martha together fulfill Jesus' calling when He visited their home?
7. Greg challenged us to remember whose we are, who we are, and where we are. Which of these three do you feel you have the firmest grip on? Which one are you the least certain of?
8. Read 1 Corinthians 12:15-26. How does this passage promote unity in the church?
9. When have you seen this passage lived out in your life? What did that look like?
10. Can you recall a time when the different parts of the church's body weren't working together? What was the result?
