
The Rising CULTIVATING PASSION FOR JESUS

Retreat

IS THERE A COST?

The Rising is completely free! We do charge for The Rising Retreat in order to offset the cost of lodging and food.

WHAT IF WE MISSED THE RETREAT?


Not a problem! Your student is still eligible to join The Rising. We encourage every student to come and jumpstart their friendships with other students.



Why The Rising?


THE RISING

In 2007, Pew Research Center found 78% of Americans identified as Christian and 16% identified as "No Religion." Fast forward to 2021, only 63% identify as Christian with an alarming 29% now identifying as "No Religion."

Where did we loose all those Christians?

Lifeway Research found that 66% of students lose their faith in college with only 35% coming back to faith later in life. That's a 31% net loss of students abandoning the faith each year. If current trends continue, the church will lose one million youth every year for the next three decades. In other words, we are currently witnessing the single largest generational loss of souls in history...



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

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

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OUR HOPE

We want to raise up generations of students who passionately follow Jesus and make him known.

Jesus described how this would happen:

"A man scatters seed on the ground. Night and day, whether he sleeps or gets up, the seed sprouts and grows, though he does not know how. All by itself the soil produces grain—first the stalk, then the head, then the full kernel in the head. As soon as the grain is ripe, he puts the sickle to it, because the harvest has come."

God is responsible for growing and sustaining this passion in our students; we are called to scatter seed and gather the harvest. And like a good farmer, we can help cultivate and prepare our students for the trials of our time.

OUR RESPONSE

There are three ways we can cultivate passion for Jesus: Till the Soil, Add Nutrients, and Create an Environment. We'll explore each of these topics at our Legacy Nights (see page ____).

We must realize today's students are being exposed to errors about the Bible, Christianity and the church earlier than ever before.
