### **Key Passage**

Revelation 3:21-22

"To the one who is victorious, I will give the right to sit with me on my throne, just as I was victorious and sat down with my Father on His throne. Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches."

#### **Disscussion Questions**

- 1. Revelation 2-3 contain 7 letters that God instructed John to write to churches in significant port cities. The end of each letter contains the phrase, "Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches." Why do you think this is included?
- 2. Read Revelation 3:20-21. What is the significance of God knocking vs. barging His way in?
- 3. Considering the context of father and child, what hope does Revelation 3:21 give you?
- 4. Read Revelation 3:15-16. How do you interpret these verses?
- **5.** Have you ever seen the result of your giving? If so, what was the result? If not, do you wish you could see the results?
- **6.** What temperature would you gauge your faith to be? What can you do to raise that tempe
- 7. One of the problems with the churches in this time is that they were being heavily influenced by the culture around them and were falling away from God. How do you see this happening in our culture today? How do you see it in your life?
- **8.** Read James 1:13-14. When you feel tempted to give into the culture around you, who do you blame for that temptation, and who actually deserves the blame?
- **9.** Read Philippians 3:13-14. Paul uses descriptive language like "straining" and "press on" to describe how he's moving toward God's goodness. In what ways have you had to strain or press on to maintain and grow your faith?
- **10.** Read Revelation 3:19. Does it feel odd to hear God say that the ones He rebukes and disciplines are actually the people He loves?
