What's your favorite battle scene from a movie or TV show?

Key Passage

Revelation 17:14-17

"They will wage war against the Lamb, but the lamb will triumph over them because he is Lord of lords and King of kings—and with Him will be His called, chosen and faithful followers. Then the angel said to me, 'The waters you saw, where the prostitute sits, are peoples multitudes, nations, and languages. The beast and the ten horns you saw will hate the prostitute. They will bring her to ruin and leave her naked; they will eat her flesh and burn her with fire. For God has put it into their hearts to accomplish His purpose by agreeing to hand over to the beast their royal authority, until God's words are fulfilled."

Discussion Questions

1. Revelation speaks of an unholy trinity: the dragon (Satan), the beast from the sea (the antichrist), and the beast from the earth (the false prophet). Does this imagery help you better understand the enemy and the battle that's coming?
2. In Revelation 17:16-17, God's enemies turn on and destroy one another. When have you seen God take something meant to harm or destroy you and turn it into a victory?
3. In Revelation 17:5, our enemy is identified as Babylon. In the Old Testament, Babylon overtook Jerusalem and, during its reign over God's people, caused many to abandon God and adopt their customs and culture. How have you seen today's culture impact Christianity?
4. Have you compromised your Christian beliefs to conform with society? If so, how? What was the result?
5. Zach made the point that, in the battle for our souls, one of the greatest tactics of the enemy is to lure us to his side without us even realizing we just went to the other side. Have you ever experienced this?
6. How have you seen Satan subtly use elements of God's truth to create counterfeit religious systems?
7. Does the knowledge that God is just give you a sense of peace in regard to those who have wronged you?
8. Does your faith life ever feel like a fight? Do you have to battle for your beliefs?
9. Does your faith feel strengthened from reading Revelation 17-18? In what ways?
