Week 1

Icebreaker

Do you have a resolution for 2024? If so what is it?

Key Passage

Matthew 6:9

“This, then is how you should pray: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.”

Discussion Questions

1. What is your overall approach to prayer? How do you pray?
2. Do you feel an intimacy with God through prayer? If not, how might you find that feeling?
3. What's the most difficult part of prayer for you? What's the easiest part?
4. What meaning does the Lord's Prayer have to you? Is it something you think about? Use as a model for your prayers? Or do you have it memorized?
5. The Lord's Prayers leads off by addressing "our Father in heaven." How does the concept of speaking with God as your dad make you feel? How does it affect how you pray?
6. Part of the Lord's Prayer says: "give us our daily bread." Do you trust God with your present circumstances? Do you believe He keeps supplying day by day? Why or why not?
7. Read Philippians 4:19. How has God always met your needs?
8. Read Philippians 4:19. How has God always met your needs?
9. Which do you find more difficult to do: ask for forgiveness or forgive others? Why?
10. Read Ephesians 4:31-32. Why do you think forgiving others is difficult? What are some strategies you use to forgive others?
