Memorization Helps

Use simple hand motions for each phrase:

- "I praise you" raise hands in praise
- "because I am fearfully and wonderfully made" gesture to self with both hands
- "your works are wonderful" thumbs-up or hands outstretched
- "I know that full well" point to your head
