What We Covered

Take Away Point: The Bible is God's true, inerrant Word, our foundation for life and faith.

Key Verse: 2 Timothy 3:16 "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness"

Why We Talked About It

In a world that is lacking trust, this week we discuss whether the Bible is trustworthy or not. Is this just an old book? OR The true and living Word of God?

What You Can Do

Discussion Starters

- Why is the Bible different from other books?
- Why does it matter that the Bible has no errors?
- How do we rely on it in our family?
- How does the Bible help you know God?
- What are some things people think the Bible says, but it doesn't?

Check on the Challenge: Each student be in the word this week 3 times: devotion, Bible app, memory verse, etc.

- What do you see, what does it mean for you, and pray!

Memory Word: Inerrant

Meaning: The Bible is totally true and without error, because God Himself is the source.
Tie in the Catechism: "He calls us through the Gospel and enlightens us with His gifts..."
