The Miracles of Jesus

What We Covered

Take Away Point: Miracles reveal Jesus' power, compassion, and identity as God's Son.

Key Verse: John 2:11 “This, the first of his signs, Jesus did at Cana in Galilee, and manifested his glory. And his disciples believed in him.”

Why We Talked About It

A large part of Jesus’ ministry was performing miracles. Through his miracles he cared for those in need, not those in power. The call of Jesus isn’t to gain power but to care for those in front of us.

What You Can Do

Choose a miracle story and Discuss:

- John 2:1–11 (Water into Wine)
- Mark 2:1–12 (Paralyzed Man)
- Mark 4:35–41 (Calming the Storm)
 - Why do you think Jesus did this miracle?
 - What does this teach us about His power or compassion?
 - What would you ask Jesus to heal or fix if He were here?
 - How does God still show His power and compassion?

Ask your child about their takeaway from the lesson.

Memory Word: Miracle

Definition: A miracle is a powerful act of God that shows His love and control over creation.
