Jesus healed the paralyzed man—but first He forgave him. Miracles aren't just about fixing problems. They reveal Jesus' care for our deepest needs.

“Which is easier: to say to this paralyzed man, ‘Your sins are forgiven,’ or to say, ‘Get up, take your mat and walk’?” – Mark 2:9
