Not sure where to serve? Here are some ideas to help you get started:

Abide: Abide strives to revitalize the inner city by developing stronger families, safer neighborhoods, and emerging leaders. Volunteer opportunities include preparing the food pantry, serving food to the community, and beautifying campuses and surrounding areas. You can even volunteer for unique group opportunities.

Open Door Mission: The goal of <u>Open Door Mission</u> is to end the cycle of homelessness and poverty in Omaha. Hand of Hope: <u>Hand of Hope</u> aids those impacted by natural disasters all over the country by rebuilding homes, churches, and communities in devastated areas. If your group can <u>make a trip together</u>, that's fantastic! But if that's not possible, you could have a group fundraiser (such as a bake sale or a group garage sale) to raise funds to <u>donate</u>.

Embrace Teachers: Embrace Teachers enriches the lives of educators at seven schools in the Omaha Public School District by providing conference meals, classroom supplies, encouragement gifts and cards, and prayer.
